# **Audition Packet for Annie – Summerset Theatre Season 56**

The character of *Little Orphan Annie* is truly an American iconic.

This will be the third time Summerset Theatre will bring this large cast, family friendly musical to the stage. It is important to realize that the Broadway musical we are producing includes several songs that are different from many "movie" versions of the show.

## THE AUDITION PROCESS

Everyone will be taught music, movement and asked to sing. Everyone will also have the opportunity to read for different roles. This show is very vocally and physically demanding. The entire ensemble will be playing multiple roles with many, many costume changes.

We will start each Audition Session with the KIDS (age 8-16) at 6:00pm (Fri) or 9:00am (Sat)

Kids will be taught music and a short dance from *Hard Knock Life* and read a quick scene from the show. Call backs for the role of Annie may be required. We are looking to cast 12-15 orphans. However, please note that only 6 orphans (Molly, Kate, Tessie, Pepper, July, and Duffy) have speaking roles.

We will continue each Audition Session for the ADULTS (16+) at 7:30pm (Fri) or 10:30am (Sat)

#### THE REHEARSAL PROCESS

Rehearsals will start the first week in May AND will generally be in the evening from 6-10pm with an occasional Saturday for choreography. Soloists and small groups will also arrange rehearsal time to work with the Vocal Director and/or the Choreographer one-on-one prior to putting big production numbers together with the entire cast. Please note that participating in a theatre production is a time-intensive activity. We will try to work around conflicts to the best of our ability, but having too many conflicts <u>may prohibit</u> you from being cast in the show.

Cast members are required to be <u>on time</u> for all scheduled rehearsals, performances, and meetings. Cast members must provide their own transportation to and from the theatre.

## **CAST OF CHARACTERS**

## Annie (female, 10-12ish)

Street-wise orphan who is eventually taken in by Oliver Warbucks. Spunky, friendly, big-voiced.

## Oliver Warbucks (male, 30-60ish)

A successful businessman with a warm heart. Rich, stiff-collared, bullish.

## **Grace Farrell (female, 25-45ish)**

Faithful secretary to Mr. Oliver Warbucks. Poised, sweet, gentle.

## Orphans (females, 8-13ish) Includes Molly, Kate, Tessie, Pepper, July, Duffy, and more

Girls at the orphanage with Annie. They are gritty, neglected and vulnerable, yet basically honest and potentially loveable.

## Miss Hannigan (female, 30-60ish)

Orphanage matron who hates children but is fond of liquor. Very disillusioned, bitter, and cold.

## Rooster Hannigan (male, 25-50ish)

Miss Hannigan's no-good brother looking for a quick buck. A sleazy, slick con man.

#### Lily St. Regis (female, 20-45ish)

Rooster's girlfriend, who is also out for a quick buck. She is considered to be a floozy and bimbo.

**Young Starlet (female, 20-30ish)** Just arrived in NYC and wants to be a star.

## Servants (any gender, any age)

Staff at the Warbucks mansion. Includes Drake, Mrs. Pugh, Mrs. Greer, Cecille, Annette, and others

## Hooverville Citizens (any gender, any age)

Homeless people living on the streets of New York City. Includes **Artie, Mary, Eddie, Fred, Appleseller, Sophie, Peggy, Ira, Jane, and others.** 

NYC Workers (male, 20-40ish) Includes Mr. Bundles, Lt. Ward, Policemen, Dog Catchers.

Radio Station Staff (any gender, any age) Includes Johnson, Wacky, Sound Effects, and others.

Cabinet Members of the President (any gender, 30-60ish) Includes Ickes, Perkins, Hull, and others.
